Abstract Submission Guidelines

Potential speakers can submit their expression of interest via the abstract submission form on the conference website, or via video.

A completed abstract submission form will include a brief biography detailing the experience, knowledge and current area of practice of potential speakers.

Presenters will be selected for a short 15-20 minute oral presentation, a 45 minute informative presentation and discussion or a 100 minute interactive workshop. There will also be an opportunity to include two or three symposia in the program.

Submissions should be framed around one of the conference themes and should not exceed 350 words (excluding references).

Videos should be no longer than 5 minutes.

Submissions should be made via the abstract submission form on the conference website www.literacylanguageconf.com by 1st October 2021.
